Downtown revitalization for Arcata, restored historic homes in Arcata which started the movement to "Save Arcata Historic Resources" instead of tearing them down, bringing the California Main Street Program to California, started the Arcata Downtown Business Community which morphed into the Arcata Main Street Program, Sculptures into downtown Arcata and the Guintoli roundabouts, coordinated landscaping of downtown bulb outs, build out on a vacant lot in 2004/2005 to fill in the north side of the Plaza, been an advocate for preserving Arcata heritage, scaling back the freeway from 6/8 lanes to 4/6 lanes, fought for the Arcata Marsh and Wildlife Sanctuary project, supported preserving Redwood National Park.
